The surprise rate hike last Thursday looks set to cause waves in the South African economy - many believe that it could backfire and as a result increase pressure on the weaker Rand.

Many would hope that the hike was a once off, but it may not be - and some observers feel that it may cause a preemptive spending spree on imported items.

The announcement could be indicative of a problem with our inflation targeting methods where authorities can sustain a strong Rand policy long enough to keep import costs under control (for this in turn to have a positive effect on the inflation target).



While feelings are mixed, the rate hike could very possibly stabilize as well as strengthen the Rand – which would be in opposition with the desired effect of bringing SA's external accounts under control.
